Friends of Bosque del Apache NWR encourages our members, donors, and sponsors to write letters with substantive comments to USFWS at Bosque del Apache concerning their plans to expand hunting at the refuge.

This proposal to expand hunting was directed by U.S. Department of Interior Secretarial Order 3356 to expand hunting opportunities on public lands, including the National Wildlife Refuge System (other Interior public land management agencies are included in the Order).

The Board of Directors of Friends of Bosque del Apache has submitted formal input, opposing the plan for expansion (Alternative B). The Board is in favor of Alternative A - the "no action" alternative, leaving things as they currently are.
