ORDER AWARDING ATTORNEYS' FEES

- 1. It has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter;
- 2. The Socorro Electric Cooperative, Inc. by the legitimate act of its members has chosen to voluntarily be subject to the Open Meetings Act (Sec. 10-15-1 et seq., NMSA, 2003) and the State Inspection of Public Records Act (Sec. 14-3-1 et seq., NMSA, 2003).
- 3. Pursuant to Sec. 10-15-3 (c) of the Open Meetings Act, reasonable attorney's fees may be awarded to a successful party.
- 4. The firms of Deschamps & Kortemeier Law Offices, P.C., and Ikard Wynne have represented successful parties in this matter.
- 5. It is in the interest of justice to award reasonable attorneys fees to the *pro se* litigants, Fitch and Taush as successful parties in this matter.
