District 2 (Lemitar area) has gathered more than the required number of signatures to force a hearing to recall Paul Bustamante. [Board President Recall Petition](#) 

District 3 (City of Socorro) has started a recall petition drive. Of the five present trustees in District 3, they have chosen Donald Wolberg as the lead off. Mr. Wolberg has been granted this honor because so many members consider that he has betrayed them by running as a reform candidate and then joining the board majority in actions detrimental to the members' interests. Cited are the expensive Informational Meeting of March, 2010 which became a propaganda session contained in a lecture, the improper ballot at the April, 2010 Annual Members' Meeting where the trustees offered alternates to the member passed propositions. This ballot included threatening comments and untruths and voting was held by a show of hands which limited members' freedom of action as opposed to a secret ballot. Mr. Wolberg's actions at trustee meetings are little more than lengthy rants containing personal insults and falsehoods.
