HB42 - Coop voting by mail has passed the Senate Rules Committee and gone on to SCORC (Senate Corporations and Transportation Committee). Let us hope that it will get to the floor of the Senate quickly as next Friday is the last day of this legislative session.

Wednesday, March 16, 2011 is the date of the District 2 Hearing for the Removal of Paul Bustamante from the SEC Board of Trustees. Registration is from 5:30 p.m. to 7 p.m. with the actual business of the hearing beginning at 7 p.m. District 2 members must register if they want to vote. People from all of the SEC districts called attention to the improper times originally posted and are to be congratulated for standing up for proper meeting times. Congratulations and here is more work for all you members.

Please call your friends, relatives, business associates, etc. in District 2 and urge them to attend the Recall Hearing and vote to remove Trustee Bustamante. We must begin to clean up the board now.
