September 22 - "SEC Bylaws. Article V. Section 2.

All trustees shall be elected by secret ballot, from and by the members of the district they represent, to serve until the expiration of their four year term of office or until their successors shall have been elected and shall have qualified or as otherwise provided by these By-Laws. Trustees shall be elected by a plurality vote of the members of the district present and voting.

District meetings which are held for the election of trustees which fail to have a quorum present shall result in the incumbent trustee serving until the next special meeting which will be held within one year. If the special meetings fails to have a quorum, the the incumbent trustee shall serve the remainder of his/her term (3 years)."

Obviously this Bylaw needs some revision. Also check out Dave Wade's ad in the "Chieftain" which tells people to "Vote by Mail." The lack of a quorum could result in his election despite the actual vote by the members. Brace yourself for another law suit in that case.

September 17 -

Those of you living in District 4 should be receiving your "Vote by Mail Ballot Request Notice" today. Watch for it! It will be blue and according to folks who have already received theirs, the print is small. A copy of the ballot has been requested for review. More information when it is available.

The most important item is the telephone number to call to request a ballot. Have a copy of your SEC bill handy as they will want your account number.

September 11 -

Now is the time to elect new trustees to the SEC Board. The first of the three 2012 elections is October 6, 2012 in District 4. The candidates are David Wade, a 25 year incumbent, and Gayl Dorr, the challenger. Twenty-five years is long enough for any office holder.
