Kirtland AFB conducting exercises June 5-11, 2014

Albuquerque, NM – June 3, 2014. Kirtland Air Force Base Pararescue School will be conducting training exercises on the Magdalena Ranger District June 5-11, 2014. The training exercises will be held off of Forest Service Road 354 north of Magdalena. Approximately 40 people will participate in this exercise.

The schedule is as follows:

- June 5: Set up base camp and conduct route reconnaissance.
- June 6: Students and additional instructors will arrive.
- Jun 6-11: Training exercises will be conducted both day and night.
- June 11: Pack up camp by noon and return to Kirtland AFB

Please be aware that during this exercise, you may see some smoke in the training area. The smoke will be coming from containment barrels, and will be closely monitored by the military who will have water and staff on hand.
