

Grant County Passes Wild & Scenic Resolution!

Thanks to you and thousands of other friends of the Gila, the Grant County Commission passed a resolution in support of a Wild and Scenic designation for the Gila River, the San Francisco River, and their main tributaries on September 12th! Thank you for making your voice heard.

This is a major step forward in efforts to permanently protect the Gila and the traditional uses of the river.

The resolution sends a clear message to U.S. Senators Tom Udall and Martin Heinrich that Grant County residents value the Gila River and want it to be protected in its free-flowing state for generations to come.

The Grant County Commission is now calling on Sens. Udall and Heinrich to introduce Wild and Scenic legislation in the Senate. The Senators' local staff members have been meeting with the public about a Wild and Scenic Gila River for months and continue to rely on your feedback.

Call Senators Udall and Heinrich and urge them to introduce a bill to protect the Gila.
