SB 337 Water Security Planning Act

Tomorrow, Mon., March 6, at 1:30 p.m., Room 322, Senate Finance will hear SB 337 Water Security Planning Act. This is the highest priority water bill this session. It would establish a long-term framework for state-funded regional water security planning – community driven, science-based, and focused on resilience, sustainability, and equity. Also FYI: the Senate Conservation Committee issued a Do Pass report on this bill, with a few modifications.
